DIVERSITY RULES!

*The wetland indicator status ratings is based on the US Army Corps of Engineers' 2020 Wetland Plant List for the Atlantic and Gulf Coastal Plain region.

OBL: Almost always occurs in wetlands (Obligate Wetland)

FACW: Usually occurs in wetlands (Facultative-Wetland)

FAC: Occurs in wetlands and non-wetlands (Facultative)

FACU: Usually occurs in non-wetlands, but may occur in wetlands (Facultative-Upland)

UPL: Almost never occurs in wetlands (Upland)

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
